Brisbane City Council Light Emitting Diode (LED) Road Sign program Installation at Grandview Road, Pullenvale in March

You may be interested to know, Council is delivering the LED Road Sign program as part of their ongoing commitment to improving the safety of Brisbane's streets. Council has committed \$3.24 million over four years to fund this new road safety program.

The aim of the program is to reduce the number of accidents and near misses at known accident hotspots through the installation of highly visible LED road signs. The signs will be installed on the approach to intersections and other traffic hazards including pedestrian crossings and winding roads. The signs are designed so the LEDs activate (light) when a vehicle is travelling above a pre-determined speed threshold on approach to the hotspot.

As your local Councillor, I am aware that speeding is an issue in your street and as such, I have arranged to have a 'Slow Down' LED road sign installed to address this. Council is proposing to install the permanent LED road sign in your street, on the verge outside your property in March, 2017. The signs will operate 24 hours a day.

In addition, I have enclosed a fact sheet which contains further information about the program.
