



PULLENVALE SCIENCE COMPETITION

This year's theme is 'What will your Earth be like in the future?' to coincide with National Science Weeks theme - Future Earth. Students are required to undertake an investigation around the topic relating to the theme of a sustainable planet and to predict what their Earth will be like in the future. This could include recycling, energy saving, conservation, farming, climate change etc. There are plenty of resources online around this theme. All submitted materials must be wholly designed and produced by the entrant. The entries will be judged by the members of Science Club, Mr Symes and Mrs Stewart.

Each entry **MUST** be accompanied by an entry form downloaded from the Pullenvale Website or from the office. Please note that each student who enters will receive a certificate so it is important to ensure that student names can be clearly read.

Each submission should contain a title, a written element and a visual element. Submissions should include a brief written summary of no more than one A4 page which gives an overview of the entry and explains why they have chosen it.

For the visual element, entrants could submit their projects in any form, such as:

- Pictures and words on a collage
- A video or DVD presentation (maximum five minutes)
- Computer graphics or other digital media
- Poster 841mm x 591mm in landscape or portrait
- A song or poem with an image or images to compliment it
