 - Reading, Year 3 from 78.5% in 2014 to 80% in 2015 (Yr 5, 63.9% to 70%)
 - Writing, Year 3 from 73.8% in 2014 to 80% in 2015 (Yr 5, 41% to 50%)
 - Spelling, Year 3 from 63.1% in 2014 to 70% in 2015 (Yr 5, 44.3% to 50%)
 - G&P, Year 3 from 80% in 2014 to 85% in 2015 (Yr 5, 70.5% to 75%)
 - Number, Year 3 from 50.8% in 2014 to 55% in 2015 (Yr 5, 44.3% to 50%)
